



# 2019 Richmond Tacky Light Tours

## *Guidelines*

Virginia Limousine Association has been collaborating with Richmond police officers, administrators, fire/EMT, and transportation providers to create a safe and positive Tacky Light Tour experience for all involved, including passengers, decorated home owners, neighbors, and sightseers in personal vehicles. If you participate in Tacky Light Tours, please be sure your drivers are in compliance with and your tour passengers are aware of the below guidelines.

### **DRIVERS**

- Pre-plan your route with the group.
- Review the "Guest Guidelines" with passengers before departing.
- Follow route directions provided by traffic control.
- Do not stop at homes. Tour vehicles should be continuously moving at a slow pace.
- Only stop at Cul-De-Sacs when buses cannot enter.
- Turn headlights off when parked.
- Do not double park.

### **GUEST**

- Do not walk in any yards.
- Never touch decorations.
- No alcohol outside of any vehicle.
- Dispose of trash properly.
- Music should not be heard outside your vehicle.
- Use language suitable for families.
- Chose off days to visit for less traffic; Monday – Thursday
- Most lights come on at 5:30pm.
- Do not tour after 10pm on weekdays or 11pm on weekends. Most lights will be turned off after that.
- Some home owners turn lights off in the rain.
- Plan for restroom breaks through-out the tour at least every hour.
